The workshop showed how email service allows users to send and receive messages via the internet. It is widely used for personal, academic, and professional communication.

- **Compose E – Mail:** Participants composed email and shared to respective person and learnt Setting up professional email signatures, text styles etc.
- **Carbon copy and Blind Carbon Copy:** Participant analyzed the difference between Cc and Bcc by sharing e-mails.

Google Drive

The workshop showed how Google Drive is a cloud storage service that allows users to store, access, and share files online from any device.

- Participants learned how Google Drive is used for Storing notes, assignments, and projects in one place.
- Collaborating on group projects with Docs, Sheets.
- Submitting assignments through shared links.
- Organizing semester-wise folders.

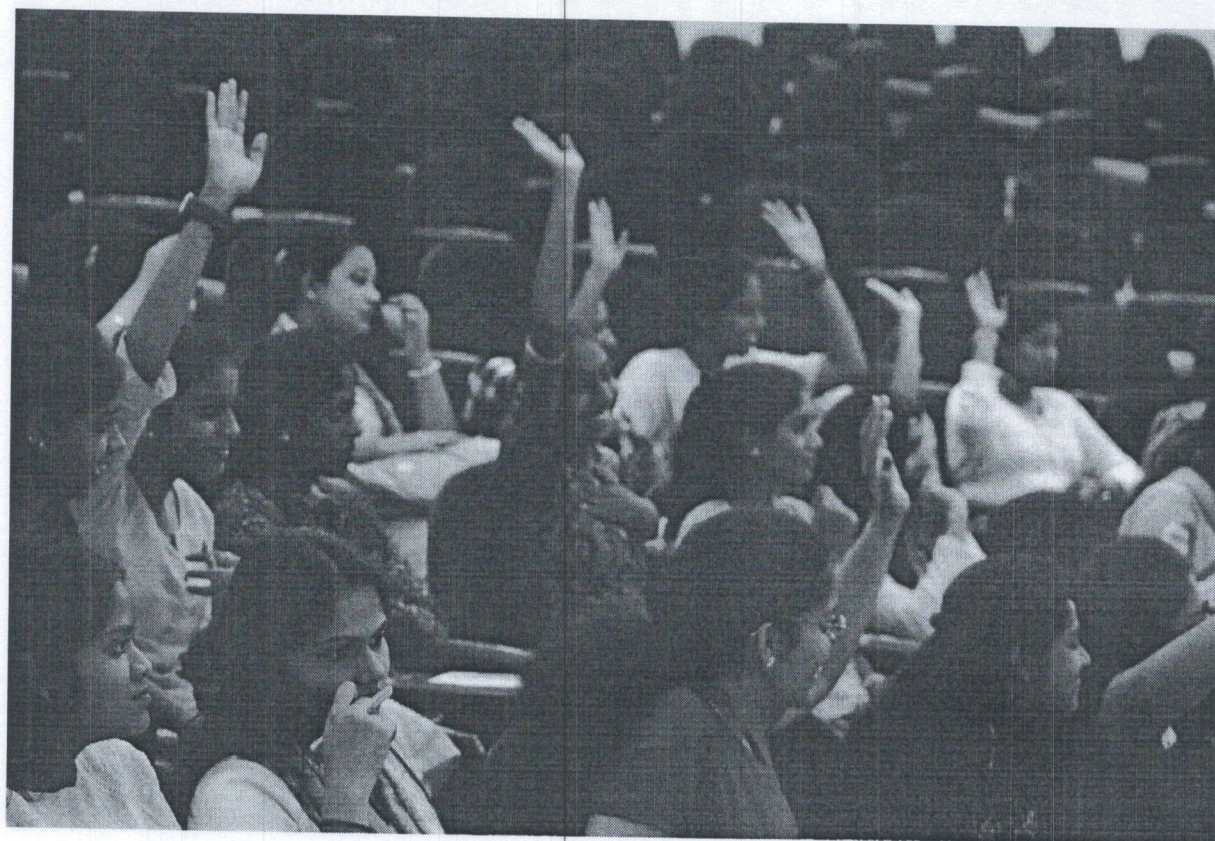

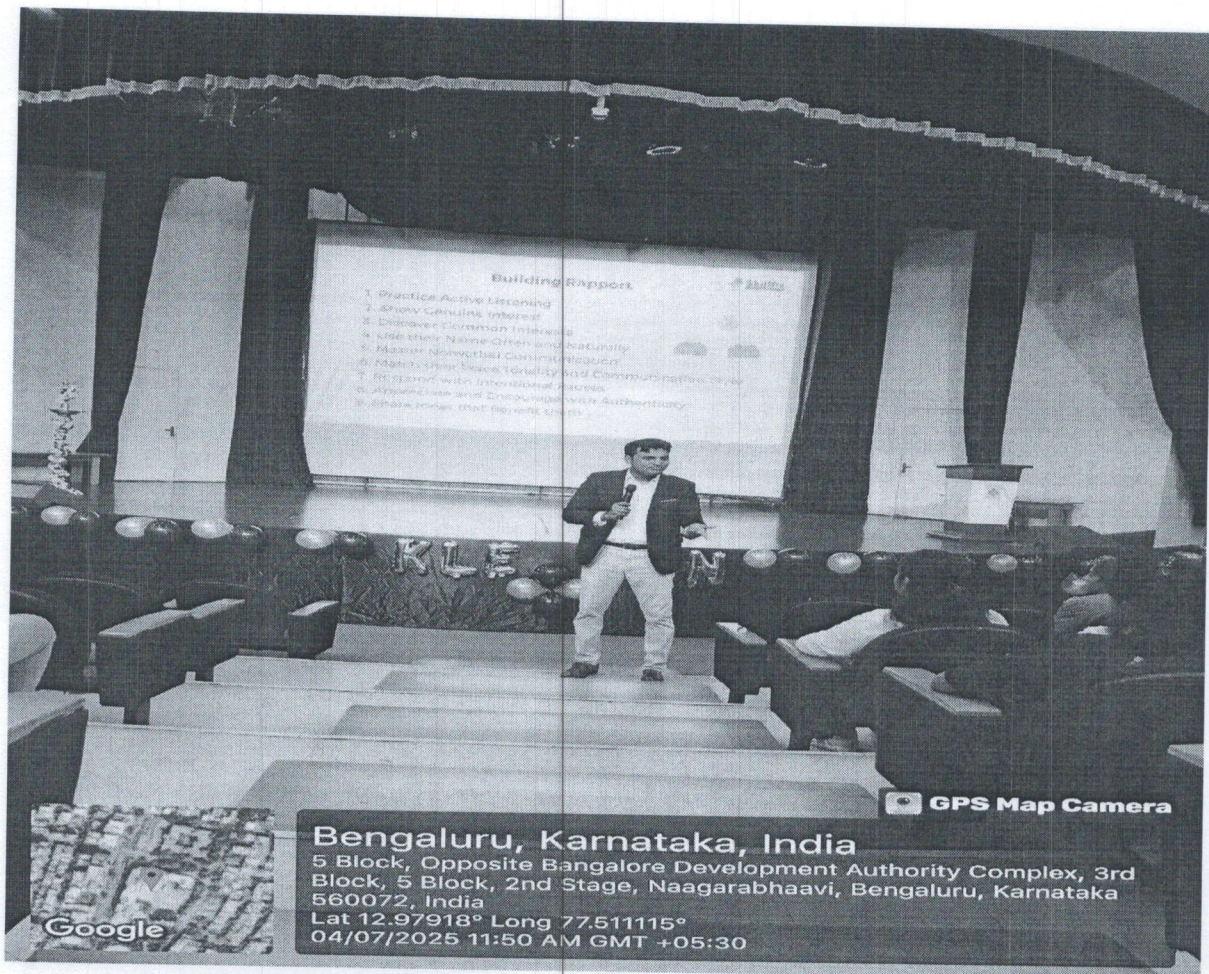
